

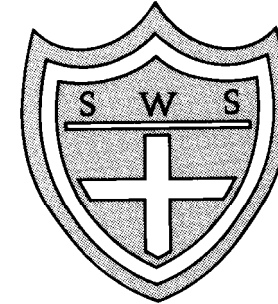

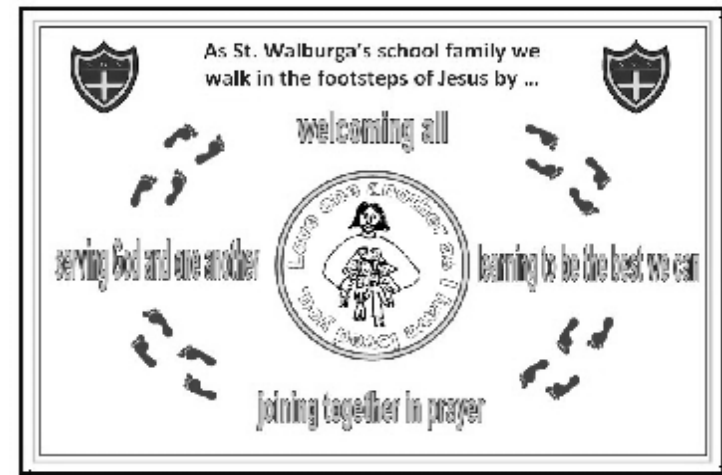
In this school:

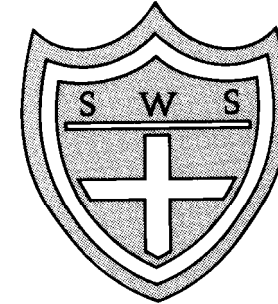

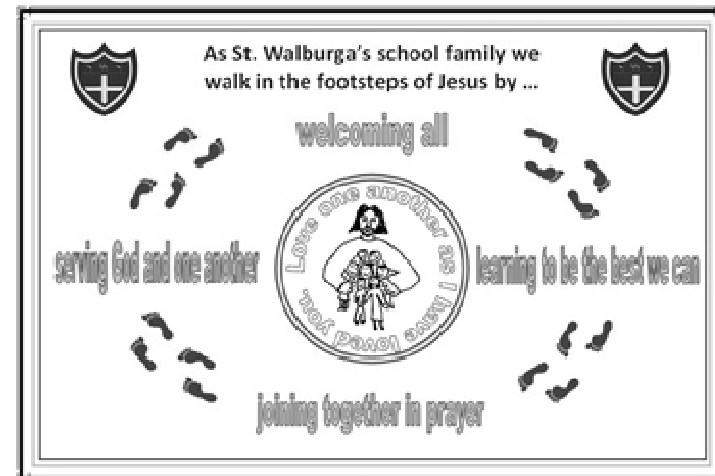
