





















Find one that will bring a smile</p>  <p>Sorrowful Mystery – The Agony in the Garden – Think of Jesus praying to his Father in Heaven.</p> 	<p>8 Always remember to say thank you for the things we take for granted and help someone when they are in trouble.</p> <p>Sorrowful Mystery – The Scourging at the Pillar – Pilate said "What am I to do with Jesus who is called Christ?" Think about the people's response.</p> 	<p>9 Say the Rosary for the elderly today.</p> <p>Sorrowful Mystery – The Crowning with Thorns Think about Jesus, how brave he was and how alone he must have felt.</p> 	<p>10 Pray for those less fortunate and share our Harvest with them.</p> <p>Luminous Mystery – The Proclamation of the Kingdom. Jesus said "Repent, for the Kingdom of God is at hand." He asks us to love our enemies, do kind deeds and be humble. Ask God to forgive your sins.</p> 	<p>11 Thank God for nature's beauty.</p> <p>Sorrowful Mystery – The Crucifixion Jesus died on the Cross to take away all our sins. Say sorry for something you have done wrong.</p>

Jesus said "Can a camel fit through the eye of a needle? It is very hard for a rich man to enter Heaven." What do you think Jesus meant? <i>Mark 10:17-30</i></p> 	<p>14 Telephone your Grandparents, Aunts, Uncles or someone special, just to say "Hello".</p> <p>Luminous Mystery – The Baptism in the River Jordan Think about Jesus being baptised in the River Jordan. Imagine you were there. Who baptised him?</p> 	<p>15 Our Lady of the Rosary Pray for all Mums today.</p> <p>Luminous Mystery – The Wedding at Cana. When Jesus changes water in to wine at the wedding, he opens the hearts of his Disciples to faith. Can you remember why he did it?</p> 	<p>16 Look around the playground and play with someone who looks lonely.</p> <p>Sorrowful Mystery – The Carrying of the Cross - Remember the stories we've heard about this journey. Who was brave and tried to help him?</p> 	<p>17 It's not how much you do but how much you put into the doing and sharing with others that matters.</p> <p>Luminous Mystery – Transfiguration Jesus was transfigured before Peter, James & John. His face became as dazzling as the sun, his clothes as radiant as light. A voice said "This is my beloved Son, listen to Him."</p> 	<p>18 St. Luke Patron: Artists & Physicians. He wrote a Gospel & which other book in the bible?</p> <p>Luminous Mystery – The Institution of the Eucharist - Jesus took bread, blessed it: "Take and eat, this is My Body." In the Mass we offer ourselves to God, and God gives himself to us. Think about the Last Supper.</p>
