Thank you very much for responding to our Parent Questionnaire – it is great to hear your views!

Here are some of the highlights!

- 100% of parents agreed that the school has a caring atmosphere with relationships based on Gospel values.
- 99% agreed that everyone is made to feel welcome.
- 98% agreed that their child enjoys school.
- 99% agreed that staff expect their child to work hard and do his or her best
- 99% agreed that their child is well taught at school.
- 98% agreed that the school encourages parents to play an active part in the religious and worshipping life of the school
- 100% said that they regarded the school as a loving, caring community.
