In our outdoor PE lessons we will be learning the skills required for Tag Rugby and Athletics. In Tag Rugby, we will be developing our defending and attacking skills, whilst thinking about game tactics. In Athletics, we will be developing our running, jumping and throwing skills over different distances as well as using the fitness zone and planning fitness sessions.



In our indoor PE lessons we will be focussing on gymnastics, we will be learning the different types of jumps, rolls, vaults and transitions between holds. The children will then create their own gymnastics performance and they will have the opportunity to act as judges. We will also be having swimming lessons at Littledown.

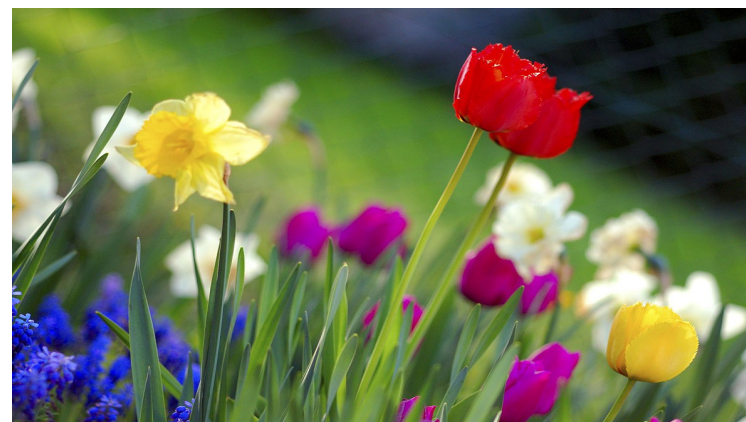
HOW YOU CAN HELP YOUR CHILD

Parent's Guide to the Year 6 Curriculum - Spring Term

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

In RE this term we will be studying the following topics:

- Revelation
- Lent
- Easter
- Other Faiths



LITERACY

This term we will be writing for a variety of purposes, including: dairy entries, poetry, narratives, formal letters, balanced arguments and persuasive advertisements. We will be using the following texts to inspire our writing: Windrush Child, The Journey, Skellig and The Boy in the Tower. We will also be revising the range of grammar skills and punctuation that could be used within our writing, including semi-colons, fronted adverbials and relative clauses.

In our Reading lessons, we will be using our class texts to develop our Vocabulary, Inference, Prediction, Explanation, Retrieval and Summarising skills.

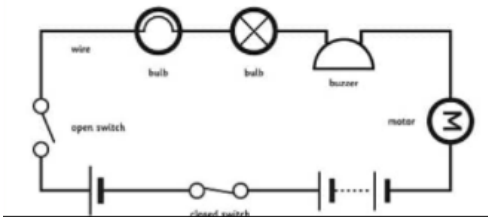
MATHS

Throughout the Spring Term we will be reinforcing and extending our knowledge of fractions. We will also be learning about percentages, focusing on the equivalence between decimals, percentages and fractions. We will also be learning about shapes, particularly circles, where the children will learn about the radius and diameter. We will be learning about angles within triangles and quadrilaterals. After that we will move on to ratio and proportion.

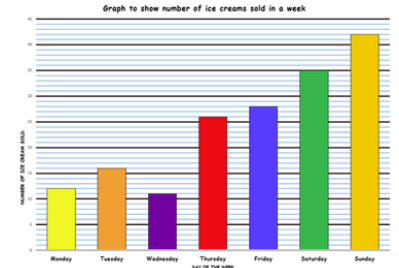
SCIENCE

In Science this term we will be learning about electricity. We will be focusing on how electrical circuits are made up and the children will learn to represent the specific symbols for each component. We will be carrying out experiments, particularly thinking about if it is a 'fair test'. Also, we will be learning about evolution, particularly focusing on how features are inherited.



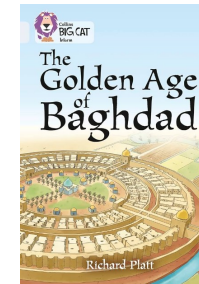
COMPUTING

This term, the children will begin to develop their data handling skills. We will be particularly focusing on using the SUM and AVERAGE tools in excel to work out totals and averages of a set of data. We will also be learning how to make different graphs from a set of data, in order to make data more visual and easy to read. We will also be introducing the children to Python Coding.



Topic

In the Spring Term, our history topic is 'The Golden Age of Baghdad'. We will be exploring the Round City and comparing life in Baghdad in 900Ce to life in Anglo-Saxon Britain. In Geography we will be getting to grips with grid references, exploring key climates of the world and identifying key geographical features on world maps.



ART

Our work in Art will be inspired by Lowry, focusing on one and two-point perspective. The children will attempt to draw their own pieces in the style of his work. The children will also be focusing on 'tie dye' and will have a go at making their own.



MUSIC

This term, we will be learning about rhythm and melody. The children will listen and appraise a range of genres. The children will also create rhyme patterns and compose their own music.



DESIGN TECHNOLOGY

In our Design Technology project we will be creating a greenhouse structure and growing food in it!
